I am Bawren Tavaziva, the Artistic Director of Tavaziva, a professional Contemporary African dance company based in London. I was born in a rural village near Masvingo in Zimbabwe. Football, Michael Jackson, New Edition and Kung Fu movies viewed at my local community hall provided inspiration to me as a young boy. My musical talents also developed at this time on a guitar made by my brother from a 5 litre tin can and fishing wire.

I attended a dance programme for underprivileged youngsters at the age of 12 where I practiced contemporary dance, ballet and traditional dance. I was selected as an apprentice for Tumbuke Dance Company in Harare, and we toured Africa and Europe for 5 years. I moved to the UK in 1998 where I performed for Phoenix Dance, Union Dance Company and others before forming my own company Tavaziva in 2004.

I am really proud of my professional company Tavaziva as we are now one of the UK's leading dance companies and we tour productions to audiences throughout the UK and abroad.

I particularly encourage boys to dance and I am very grateful to The Monument Trust for funding our programme.
